



GUEST SPEAKER NESTOR V. TAN BDO UNIBANK, INC

Nestor V. Tan is the President and CEO of BDO Unibank, Inc. He was elected to the Board of Directors on June 27, 1998. In addition to his role in BDO Unibank, Inc., he also holds the following positions in the BDO Group: Chairmanship of BDO Strategic Holdings, Inc. and BDO Network Bank, Inc.; Vice chairmanships and/or directorships in BDO Capital & Investment Corporation, BDO Finance Corporation, BDO Life Assurance Company, Inc., BDO Private Bank, Inc., and SM Keppel Land, Inc., and Trusteeship of BDO Foundation, Inc.

In addition, he is currently Chairman of Bancnet, the operator of the electronic payment system, InstaPay, and the ATM switching utility for Philippine banks; and Chairman of Mastercard Asia Pacific Advisory Board. He is the past president, director, and chairman of the Bankers Association of the Philippines. He is also the past chairman of the De La Salle University Board of Trustees.

#### **Continuation of Preparation**

#### Dear Zesters.

After a couple of "bye" weeks for our weekly meetings, we are back this Thursday in conjunction with RC Manila. Nestor Tan, President of BDO Unibank will give an insightful talk on the Philippine economy and banking landscape. I hope you can join us at the Manila Polo Club from 12-2pm on October 10, 2024.

Just a quick update on our projects the last couple of weeks. Shout out to Scott Moore and Patrick Dionisio for arranging our fellowship at the German Club last September 28, 2024. The menu was quite, masculine. Think pork knuckles (lechon kawali), sausages and booze-just what the doctor ordered!

Toshi & Rtn. RJ Tabuena (and of course their better halves) for going to the RC Nagoya 50th anniversary celebration. We can't wait to hear about it.

At the Breast and Cervical Cancer Screening held at Alabang Country Club on September 30,



2024, Chairman Dodie and team were able to screen 77 total patients. Unfortunately, 9 of the people screened had breast masses for further checking. What is more surprising is that 1 of those screened who has a breast mass is male. This is a reminder to us all that though unlikely, it is possible for males to get breast cancer and we should all be mindful of our health and check for "black swans"—events that are incredibly unlikely, but have a large impact on our life.

On October 1, 2024, Chairman Lemarc and I went to Delos Santos Medical for a truly open heart surgery. The patient, Alfred, is 6 years old. Fortunately, the surgery was a success. Upon speaking to the parents of Alfred, I learned that they had applied to Gift of Life in 2018. The reason why they did not qualify sooner is that they needed an echocardiogram. However, in Puerto Princesa (where Alfred and his family are from), the echo machine only comes around once a year when the Philippine Air Force and the medical mission team (of which Dra. Go is part of) come to visit.

Dra. Go said that for the VSD (ventricular septal defect) procedure, it is best done as early as possible in a child's life. First, there is less trauma since the child will most likely not remember the surgery. Second, it is more likely that surgeons can perform the less invasive VSD procedure where they do not have to cut open the patient's sternum but rather use thin catheters to fix the defect.

I remember what Rob Raylman said, we cannot help everyone, but we can help some. While this holds true today, the fact that Alfred had to wait 6 years before getting the surgery simply because they could not fulfill the application requirements (having an echocardiogram) seems like something we could strive to fix.

Gift of Life This Week-October 9, 2024

Dra. Louisa Go and the Jaden and Friends endorsed eleven (11) patients scheduled



for PDA, ASD, VSD, PPBV and Hemodynamic Studies on October 9, 2024 in De Los Santos Medical Center (9 patients) and Chinese General Hospital (2 patients). The procedures in Chinese General will start at 6 am and at 9 am onwards in DLSMC.

The devices for PDA and ASD were funded by the DSWD - Aics of Cong Paul Daza (4 PDA's @ 60,000/patient and 3 ASD's @ 150,000/patient).

The VSD device of 1 patient was approved by DSWD Aics in the amount of 45,000. Their municipal mayor had extended an additional 40,000. There's was shortage of PHP15,700 to make a total of 100,700 which is the cost of the VSD Device. As recommended by Chair Lemarc and PP Gil, the PHP15,700 will be taken from the cash gift of PP Gil during his speech in FEU.

The hospital bills of all 11 patients will be funded by Cong Paul's DOH - Maip funds.

Once again, many thanks to Cong. Paul, PP Gil, Chairman Lemarc, and the Gift of Life team for their continued hard work.
