### Today's word is:

### "Sassenach" (sas-uh-nuhkh)

Anyone who has been watching "Outlander" will be familiar with this term by now. It's an AWFUL series, so please stop watching it (you are just encouraging them). Honestly, its like a mixture of Brigadoon and Downton Abbey in all the worst ways.

Anyway, this is a gaelic word for a lowlander, or southerner, and most particularly for the English, being derived from the word for "Saxon". It isn't much of a compliment, even today.

# Scottish Heritage

#### **Highland Park**

Founded in 1798, the Highland Park distillery is the most northerly of all Scotch whiskies, sited in Kirkwall in the Orkney Islands. This is an island whisky, but it doesn't have the saltiness or peat of those from the Western Isles and drinks more like a Highland or Speyside for me. It is a favourite of mine, full of flavour without ripping your throat out. Very, very dangerous when you get into it.

What makes it unique? They malt their own barley using Orkney peat, which doesn't include any trees! Plus the windswept sea air probably helps a lot. They also only use sherry barrels rather than bourbon - about 10x the cost.

I'm not so sure about the new look, which as gone all "Viking" in recognition of the strong Nordic heritage of the Orkneys (they only became part of Scotland in 1468). But I suppose in a competitive market everyone is looking for something distinctive. Personally I always thought this dram spoke for itself, but what do I know!? **Tasting Note by The Chaps at Master of Malt** 

**Nose:** Fresh, clean and very aromatic. Floral notes abound the senses with a light grassiness. Notes of creamy Manuka honey and a touch of juicy citrus with cream and a well-balanced sweetness.

**Palate:** Rather full with a pleasant depth. Lurking somewhere in the substratum a grilled orange lies. Notes of granary toast and green tea with jasmine. A touch of sweetness.

Finish: Quite long with peppery spice and wood shavings.


