

GUEST SPEAKER ELI M. REMOLONA. JR. GOVERNOR, BANGKO SENTRAL NG PILIPINAS

Dr. Eli M. Remolona, Jr. is the seventh Governor of the BSP and Chairman of the Monetary Board. Governor Remolona has extensive policy and operational experience in monetary policy and international finance, having worked for 19 years at the Bank for International Settlements (BIS) and 14 years for the Federal Reserve Bank of New York.

At the BIS, he was Head of Financial Markets and Editor of the BIS Quarterly Review. Later, he became Chief Representative for Asia and the Pacific. From 2019 to 2022, Governor Remolona served as professor of finance and director of central banking at the Asia School of Business in Kuala Lumpur. He also taught at Williams College, Columbia University, New York University, and the University of the Philippines-School of Economics.

Before his appointment to the Monetary Board in 2022, Governor Remolona served as independent director of a universal bank and chairman of its risk management committee.

He earned his PhD in Economics with distinction from Stanford University and obtained his bachelor's degree in Economics with honors from the Ateneo de Manila University.





PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Welcome 2025

Welcome 2025 and Happy New Year to all! I trust that you are all well-rested, not hungover in the least, in the best shapes of your lives, and ready to build on what we have already accomplished in 2024.

The Rotary year is flying by and let's do a quick check on where we are with our programs:

Gift of Life. Last Rotary year, we helped with 305 heart surgeries in addition to the 2,521 individuals that received medical assistance through the generosity of Cong. Paul Daza.

The good: As of January 6, 2024, we are at 209 heart surgeries and are on pace to beat RCMW's personal best of 305 surgeries last Rotary year.

The bad: Lead by IPDG Jay Tambunting, we are finalizing another Global Grant. If you recall, PP Gil Chua generously gave USD 100,000 in restricted funds for our Gift of Life program. With the help of IPDG Jay, hopefully we can push this Global Grant through since by my estimation, the existing funds are not enough to cover the pace of GOL expenses at this rate.

The ugly: DSWD accreditation. We need DSWD accreditation before May 2025. I'm sounding the alarm here. I need help completing the requirements and writing narratives to fulfill the various government agencies requirements. Any takers?



Gift of Sight. Last Rotary year, we helped 187 patients with their cataracts lead by our very own Dr Timmy Tan.

The good: 84 eyes restored through cataract surgeries.

The bad: We're out of money.

The ugly: We haven't started the application of the next Global Grant for Gift of Sight.

Gift of Mobility.

The good: The club gave the Gift of Mobility to 14 amputee patients by providing artificial limbs

The bad: Last RY, we provided the gift of mobility to 105 individuals which is quite a bit higher than this RY.

The ugly: N/A

Breast and Cervical Cancer Screening. Last RY, we screened 1,133 individuals for breast and cervical cancer.

The good: RCMW screened 583 women for breast and cervical cancer, promoting early detection and saving lives. We have quite a few BCCS events scheduled for this year already.

The BCCS program has a mobile clinic equipped for VIA testing and CBE. The program provides free medical services, with the club making a token donation to help defray the costs of the mobile clinic.

HIV Caravan. Unfortunately, due to the nature of the screening and educational talks which all occur on campus (face-to-face), our HIV Caravan project was put on the back burner.

The good: The Red Whistle reached out and is back!

The bad: We may have to reallocate the remainder of the Global Grant so that we continue to be transparent and clear with Rotary International how and where we spend the funds.

Mass wedding. 12 couples were married in paco Church.

1 medical mission in Cebu in conjunction with RC Cebu.

Many of us are going to the anniversary of RC Petaling Jaya in our Malaysia. Our sister club and dear friends (Dato Kevin, Rianne, Alice, Pres. Sivanes, PP Usha, and many more) have graciously invited us to play golf, do a little touring in Malaysia, and celebrate with them.

For those who are unable to go to Malaysia, we have a joint meeting with BSP Governor Eli Remolona with RC Manila. Governor Remolon will undoubtedly give those who listen insights into the musings of our financial markets and economy.

On January 8, 2025, Wednesday, three (3) patients will be operated on at De los Santos Medical Center.

On January 11, 2025, Saturday, we have a Breast and Cervical Cancer Screening event in the hometown of PP Eric Tensuan (Tanauan, Batangas.) And to close out January,

we have seven (7) patients scheduled to be operated on in Davao Doctor's Hospital (they signed a MOU with us during our 55th/20th celebration.

Cheers to 2025 and may all your new years resolutions be worth breaking.


