I'm a big fan of Desiderata. In a single poem, so many of the themes by which I try to live my life were captured in the simplest yet most meaningful way. I particularly like this little snippet, and it is a lesson that, from the earliest days, we tried to instill in our kids. Someone would always have a better bike, newer sneakers, more pocket money, chocolate in their lunchbox etc. Sometimes that someone might be them. Not comparing is one of many small keys to happiness I think, linked to being truly and thoughtfully grateful for what we have.


SCOTCH CORNER
