

Pre-Destined

Some people are destined for the advocacies they eventually take up. Born into Rotary when his late father, PDG Jun Tambunting, formed the Rotary Club of Makati West. Jay grew up witnessing first hand his father's love for Rotary Service. With that as his inspiration, he naturally desired to manifest that same passion for service to others through Rotary.

On August 21, 2001, he became a member of RCMW, and immediately paved the road to fulfilling his dreams of truly being a man of action, a man of zest. With 22 years of Rotary involvement, Jay has embodied the many spheres of Rotary service. He believes he has so much more to offer, so much more to contribute to the the betterment of humanity through Rotary's ideals.

Lead with a Rotarian Heart

As a newly inducted Rotarian in 2001, he immediately immersed himself in Rotary service as Chairman of the Most Outstanding Teacher Award. He was recognized as the Baby Rotarian of the Year RY 2001-2002 (among 28 new Rotarians).

In 2003, he was Chairman of the RCMW Christmas Bazaar, which raised over 1 million pesos. He was recognized Rotarian of the Year RY 2003-04

As Club President RY 2006-07, he epitomized the year's theme "Lead the Way" and led many new and existing projects to greater heights:

RCMW's GIFT OF LIFE PROJECT saved the lives of 52 children with congenital heart ailments including a Medical Mission to Iloilo in partnership with RC Iloilo Metro

The WHEELCHAIR OF LIFE PROJECT purchased, imported and distributed 1,280 wheelchairs providing at least two wheelchairs to each of the 75 clubs in District 3830

The OPERATION SMILE PROJECT enabled 180 cleft surgeries to repair the smiles of beneficiaries in Cabanatuan, Tarlac City and Makati City medical missions

The GK RCMW Pinagsama Village provided free housing to 52 families with 12 homes donated in collaboration with Lead Presidents

The WATER FOR LIFE PROJECT had joint projects with RC Alabang, Las Pinas West and Muntinlupa Filinvest and installed drinking water sources in various schools and barrios Through Multi-club Meetings with Lead Presidents, hosted Rotary leaders RIPE Wilf Wilkinson and TRF Chair Luis Vicente Giay and former Peruvian President Alejandro Toledo, among others

Underwrote and supervised 12 Global and Matching Grants for the club generating more than \$1,000,000 for project funding From its inception in 2004, has been active with the club signature project- Gift of Life which has saved the lives of over 1,000 children.


