

#### GUEST SPEAKER DANTE B. CANLAS, PhD PROFESSOR EMERITUS, UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES

Dante B. Canlas is a professor emeritus at the University of the Philippines School of Economics (UPSE). He obtained both his Bachelor of Science in Mathematics and Ph.D in Economics at the University of the Philippines. He joined the UPSE faculty in 1975 where he taught courses and did research in macroeconomics, money, and labor. He held visiting appointments at Princeton University (US), Northern Illinois University (US), and the Institute of Developing Economies (Japan). He has written more than 70 articles and publications in his fields of interest. His latest publication is, "Natural Gas and Transitioning to Renewable Fuels: Considerations from Industrial Policy," in the Philippine Economic Review (December. 2024).

He served in government as Secretary of Socio-Economic Planning and concurrently NEDA Director-General. He was a member of the Board of Directors of the Philippine National Oil Company and concurrently President and CEO of the PNOC-Alternative Fuels Corporation.

He became a member of the Executive Board of the Asian Development Bank (ADB), and was Executive Director of the Constituency headed by the Philippines and Pakistan. He was the Point-of-Contact for the Millennium Challenge Corporation Compact Program in the Philippines.

Dante Canlas has done consultancy work with the World Bank, ADB, United Nations Development Programme, and some bilateral organizations like the USAID and AUSAID, as well as with some government agencies.

#### DSWD

Last Saturday, 26 January 2025, Chairman Lemarc attended the first Gift of Life program at Davao's Doctors. In November 2024, the Rotary Club of Makati West (RCMW) signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the hospital during our 55th anniversary/20th anniversary of GOL, extending RCMW's flagship Gift of Life program to Davao in partnership with Davao Doctors Hospital. This collaboration signifies the hospital's dedication to providing comprehensive healthcare services to the community.

On January 24, 2025, a significant medical milestone was achieved when Dra. Louisa Go, Dr. Stephen Cheng, and the Delos Santos Medical Center team successfully operated on seven patients, further showcasing the hospital's commitment to excellence in patient care. Davao Doctors Hospital continues to uphold the vision of its pioneering doctors, providing top-notch healthcare services to the region and beyond.

Above is the Google drive link to a shared folder with the requirements of DSWD. Here is what needs doing and what has been done so far:

1. Pre-Accreditation Assessment: This assessment, conducted by the DSWD Field Office, involves a thorough review of the agency's operations and can take time to schedule and complete. Status? Undone.

2. Development of a comprehensive Manual of Operations: Creating a detailed manual that meets all DSWD requirements involves documenting all of the agency's policies and procedures. Status? Have a look: Operations Manual

3. Compilation of Financial Documents: Gathering and preparing the required financial reports, such as the audited financial report, is done. The notarized certification from the Board of Trustees or funding agency confirming financial capacity to operate for two years also necessitates coordination and formal documentation. Status? AFS' are okay. Certification from the board, not yet.

4. Ensuring compliance with Staffing Ratios and Qualifications: Include Cynthia's profile along with other employees and volunteers, as required by the DSWD, which includes qualifications, work experience, and professional license. Status? In process.

5. Obtaining Safety Certificates: Securing the necessary safety certifications, such as the occupancy permit or the Annual Building Inspection/Structural Safety Certificate, the Fire Safety Inspection Certificate, and the Water Potability Certificate or Sanitary Permit, often requires inspections, potential building improvements, and coordination with different government agencies. Status? Done.

6. ABSNET Membership: While becoming a member of ABSNET may not be as timeconsuming as the other items, it does involve an application process, and obtaining certification of active membership will require follow-up with the regional or cluster ABSNET leadership. Status? Undone.

I'm laying this out here so that anyone who wants to help out in this process can. Please contact me if you find anything specific you'd like to work on.

For upcoming events, please give your interest for RC Petaling Jaya's Golden Child program (April 24-28, 2025) in Malaysia, RC Singapore West's induction on July 3, 2025. RC Honolulu West is inviting too for their 75th anniversary this coming October 16-18, 2025 in beautiful Hawaii.



A formal invitation with more details will follow in due time.


