### Scottish Heritage

### STIRLING

The city of Stirling (pop: 37,000 or so), always seems to be rather passed by in the Tourist Trails, which is rather a shame as it has hugely rich history and is quite quaint. Strategically it was historically of great strategic importance as it sits almost equidistant between Glasgow and Edinburgh, on the lowest fording point of the River Forth. If you wanted to go North or South, you had to pass by Stirling. Which is why they still say, "If you hold Stirling; you hold Scotland".

Dominated by Stirling Castle, which remains an army garrison to this day (my own uncle actually was stationed there in the 1950s during his military service), the city itself has intriguing medieval streets that are lovely to explore. Standing near the castle, the Church of the Holy Rude is one of the town's most historically important buildings. Founded in 1129 it is the second oldest building in the city after Stirling castle and is reputed to be the only surviving church in the United Kingdom apart from Westminster Abbey to have held a coronation

Nearby lie the fields of Bannockburn (scene of a famous defeat of the English by Robert the Bruce in 1314), and in the surrounding hills is a spectacular monument to William Wallace. I remember that edifice looming over me as a small boy, as my Dad drove us through to St Andrews on a Friday evening after school.





