**GOL** numbers


Dear Zesters,

Thanks to Chairman Lemarc Limosnero and Cong/PN Paul Daza, we are pushing the 300 operation mark for Gift of Life. That's right you heard that correct: President Nominee Paul Daza ladies and gentlemen for Rotary Year 2026-2027. The man, the civil servant, the legend himself.

Looking at the data, here are the distributions for all who are interested in this kind of thing.


1. Age Range Distribution - The majority of beneficiaries are toddlers (1-5 years old) and children (5-12 years old):






- Infants (0-1 years old): 53 beneficiaries (20.46%)
- Toddlers (1-5 years old): 99 beneficiaries (38.22%)
- Children (5-12 years old): 72 beneficiaries (27.80%)
- Teenagers (12-18 years old): 35 beneficiaries (13.51%)

2. Geographical Reach - The program has reached beneficiaries in 44 provinces. The top 10 provinces with the most recipients are:



- Metro Manila: 46 beneficiaries (15.81%)
- Batangas: 28 beneficiaries (9.62%)
- Nueva Ecija: 24 beneficiaries (8.25%)
- Rizal: 18 beneficiaries (6.19%)
- Bulacan: 14 beneficiaries (4.81%)
- Laguna: 11 beneficiaries (3.78%)
- Cavite: 10 beneficiaries (3.44%)
- Davao: 10 beneficiaries (3.44%)
- Pangasinan: 9 beneficiaries (3.09%)
- Isabela: 9 beneficiaries (3.09%)


#### 3. Most Common Medical Procedures



- Open Heart Surgery PDA Device Closure: 141 cases (61.84%)
  - Open Heart Surgery: 37 cases (16.23%)
  - VSD Open Heart: 19 cases (8.33%)
  - Procedure: 17 cases (7.46%)
  - VSD Device Closure: 14 cases (6.14%)



#### 4. Top Hospitals Handling Beneficiaries



- DLSMC: 193 cases (68.68%)
- PHC: 46 cases (16.37%)
- NCH: 17 cases (6.05%)
- Hospital: 17 cases (6.05%)
- Dr. PJRGMRMC: 8 cases (2.85%)
