PROFESSOR, UP VIRATA SCHOOL OF BUSINESS



Another thing I love to do in this stage of my life is being this club's president. I love my job! It's part of my plan to continue fulfilling this club's mission to be what we call at DDB as "Shapers of Society."

To mark our progress in the club, let me just share with you some updates:

As of March 1, we have already done 162 heart surgeries under our Gift of Life program. On top of that, we have also helped 1,447 patients through Cong. Paul Daza's payment assistance of guarantee letters.



For our Mass wedding scheduled on April 29, 2023 at the San Fernando De Dilao Parish, Paco, Manila, there are about 25 couples who have registered at the parish office. One of them is Moly Almenario, secretariat staff of RC Makati North. Our RCMW secretariat is accepting donations for this upcoming service project.

For our Artificial Limbs project, we will be doing the first casting of prosthetic limbs to 8 amputee patients on March 10 at the provincial capitol of Bulacan. In total, RCMW has submitted 33 amputee cases from Metro Manila with complete information to PGH.

For our Breast and Cervical Cancer Screening (BCCS), we will be having

another screening activity on March 10 in Barangay San Antonio, Pasig City. Note that from the total of 637 women screened by the club since October 2019, 66 have been found positive for either cervical cancer or a breast lump. Early detection has increased their chances for survival.

So that's it for our project updates. I am happy to welcome today's guest speaker, Professor Benjie Sandoval from the UP College of Business. Prof. Benjie is a sought-after management consultant of big companies and we are so lucky to have him talk about leadership in today's meeting.

FORETHOUGHT

MARIE

Marie Curie (1867-1934) was a Polish French chemist and physicist who conducted groundbreaking research on radioactivity in the 20th century. While doing so, she discovered radioactive elements polonium and radium.

She was the first woman to win the Nobel Prize twice: in Physics (1903) and in Chemistry (1911).

I've been preparing a case discussion for a Manila based under-grad program I'm conducting surrounding how Marie Curie changed the world.

It traces the critical stages of Marie's personal life and professional career.

It concludes with how Marie used her scientific discoveries to help the medical communities in the form of X-ray equipment in World War 1 and her fundraising efforts on behalf of radioactive research. "All medicine that relies on radioactivity – on irradiating people – goes back to Marie Curie". – Dr Spencer Weart, a US physics historian.

The case I'll be presenting soon explores the personal and professional choices Marie Curie made. It also talks of what she chose not to do.

Other topics include shaping character, maximizing resources, core values, boundaries, working outside one's comfort zone, new opportunities and social networks (a century before that phrase became part of our everyday lives).

I know many of you mentor emerging leaders. Reflecting on the case, here's a few provocations and learnings I've picked up that maybe of interest as part of your ongoing discussions.



- o Don't allow work to define you.
- o Dedication has consequences.
- o Stand up for causes you believe in.
- o Identify a major problem and search for solutions.
- o Imagination leads to creativity.
- o Persevere.
- o Consider lifelong volunteering (done and doing).
- o Mind your mental health.
- o Devote time to yourself.
- o Consider teaching.
- o Keep studying.
- o Passion jumps obstacles.
- o Value every minute.
- o Invest in yourselves early in your career.
- o Ensure core values guide your choices.
- o Remain deaf to little voices in your head.
- o Think and post substantively.
- o Choose a compelling topic and keep studying it.

Over to you to continue changing the world.


