PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Accountability

Dear Zesters,

'Twas an eventful week in the Philippines. Jokes first, saan natutulog si FPRRD? Hindi po sa kama, sa sa-Hague.

On March 11, 2025, former Philippine President Rodrigo Roa Duterte was arrested at Ninoy Aquino International Airport upon returning from Hong Kong. The arrest was executed based on a warrant issued by the International Criminal Court (ICC), which has charged him with crimes against humanity related to extrajudicial killings during his controversial "war on drugs" campaign.

Within 24 hours, Duterte was transferred to ICC custody in The Hague, Netherlands. President Ferdinand Marcos Jr. confirmed that an aircraft carrying Duterte departed from Manila at 11:03p.m. on March 11. The transfer process was unusually public, with Duterte's journey becoming the most monitored flight on air traffic radar systems worldwide.



During this journey, Duterte shared a video message stating, “I led our law enforcement and military. I promised to protect you and take responsibility for everything.”

Case Background and Charges

The ICC warrant addresses allegations of extrajudicial killings between 2011 and 2019, covering both Duterte’s tenure as Davao City mayor and his early presidency. According to the ICC, there are “reasonable grounds” to prosecute him for murder as a crime against humanity.

Official police statistics report approximately 6,000 fatalities from his drug war, though human rights organizations estimate the death toll could be much higher. Duterte has consistently defended his crackdown as necessary to combat street crime, while critics maintain the campaign disproportionately targeted impoverished communities.

This case marks a historic moment—Duterte is the first Asian former head of state to face an ICC indictment and the first suspect extradited to The Hague in three years.

Legal Context and Current Status

The ICC functions as a court of last resort when domestic judicial systems fail to hold powerful individuals accountable. The prosecution seemed

unlikely until recently, particularly given that the Philippines withdrew from the Rome Statute in 2019 and that Duterte’s daughter, Vice-President Sara Duterte, had allied with President Marcos in the 2022 elections.

As of March 18, 2025, Duterte remains in ICC custody awaiting trial proceedings. Human Rights Watch called his arrest “a long-overdue victory against impunity” that could bring victims closer to justice.

Public Reaction and Misinformation

The arrest has triggered intense public reaction. Supporters have gathered outside the ICC detention facility waving Philippine flags and demanding his return. The case has also spawned widespread misinformation on social media, with satirical posts and fake quotes circulating widely.

Some posts attributed fictional statements to characters from legal dramas like “Suits” and “Legally Blonde,” making it appear as though these fictional lawyers were commenting on Duterte’s case.

ICC Assistant to Counsel Kristina Conti reported that Duterte’s supporters have been spamming ICC Pre-Trial Chamber-I Presiding Judge Iulia Motoc online, calling for his release—actions Conti noted would not help his case.

The international community is closely watching this unprecedented case as it



progresses through the ICC's judicial system, with human rights advocates viewing it as a significant step toward accountability for alleged abuses during Duterte's drug war.
