











PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

ANTICIPATION AND INNOVATION: THE ULTIMATE COMPETITIVE ADVANTAGE

"The "ability to anticipate" is one of the key factors separating the giants from the good and even the great. Skate to where the puck is going, not where it is." Hockey legend, Wayne Gretzky

n business as in hockey, when we anticipate where the puck is going we get to dominate the game. Companies are always striving for a more powerful form of competitive advantage. Effectively using the principle of anticipation and innovation is the ultimate competitive advantage.

The quality guru, Dr. Edwards Deming said, "Innovation comes from the producer - not from the customer. No customer asked for a microwave oven". Henry Ford said that if he'd asked his customers what they wanted, they would've asked for a faster horse.

At the time I joined the IBM U.S. in the late 1980's, I was considered an "experienced hire"; which was unusual because the normal IBM practice was to hire fresh college graduates. So early on, Don Halsted, my immediate boss indoctrinated me that the single most important trait IBM managers look for is anticipation.

Let me share quotes from a former IBM CEO that highlights the importance of anticipation.

She talked about an inevitable fact, "Whatever business you're in - it doesn't matter - it's going to commoditize over time. It's going to devalue. You've got to keep reinventing and moving it to a higher value and what ever you do, force yourself and the organization to always do it ahead of time." - Virginia M. Rometty.

President's Message

"Anticipation is the ability to SEE the future, the skill of considering multiple scenarios that might happen in the next few seconds, weeks — noticing little things that have a big impact on our security and our success."

To Rometty's point, we have seen what happens to companies that fail to anticipate customer needs. While Apple came up with advanced phones regularly, Nokia never kept pace with changing technology and trends. Bring your future to the present.

Deb Battersby, a consultant says that "Anticipation is the ability to see the future, the skill of considering multiple scenarios that might happen in the next few seconds, weeks - noticing little things that have a big impact on our security and our success. As an entrepreneur, the better we are at anticipating the future the better we get at mitigating risk and maximizing opportunity. Fortunately, there is a process for growing this skill".

Becky Tillman, an author in her article: "The Art of Anticipation", shares 3 specific steps - S.E.E: Search - Evaluate - Execute. Here's how it could apply to our club.

SEARCH: Step 1.

Look ahead and around, regularly check our mirrors. What's behind us and past experiences can provide relevant information to apply to our current situation. Tillman warns, "The key is to continuously redirect our focus and not fixate on any one thing for too long. Our objective is to take in as much detail as we can, training ourselves for heightened awareness.

EVALUATE: Step 2.

Notice the buzz and the competitive landscape. How might these factors affect our business and relationships? In this step, Tillman says, "Asking (ourselves and others) the who, what, where, when and how questions are invaluable. The objective is to determine is there danger or upside potential, or both?"

EXECUTE: Step 3.

What best supports the results we want to achieve? According to Tillman, "Based on steps 1 & 2 we've played out several scenarios and rehearsed our responses. If A happens we do this; if B we, do that. Our actions are deliberate, mindful and in accordance with our primary outcomes ... avoid risk, seize opportunity or stay put."

Tillman further points out we need real time feedback to determine how things are changing, to know what to do next.

Thinking ahead, anticipating what might happen next, based on the clues around us is an invaluable business and leadership skill - a skill that can be strengthened through conscious practice and strategic observation.

Over 5 years ago, I conducted a negotiation skills training for middle managers. I was astounded how half of the participants did not do the pre-work assignment. They displayed no presence of mind to anticipate the likely issues that may arise during the discussions. Nor did they have pre-prepared trades, offering perceived high value to their clients, at low cost to them.

What's my point? My view, as we live in a short-term world, some (me included) may not be anticipating enough to evaluate a subject from all sides. Let's be conscious that we are not jumping to the easiest conclusion or worse, selectively choosing the evidence that supports a long-held belief. Thankfully, critical thinking is a learned skill.
