MR. JONATHAN GIL "CHEWY" CHUA

MANAGING DIRECTOR, AGILE INTELLIGENCE, INC

A digital thinker and strategist extraordinaire, Chewy Chua is the Founding Managing Director of Agile Intelligence Inc., DDB Group Philippines' data analytics unit established in 2017. He leads his team in providing clients with an array of services including social listening, reputation and crisis monitoring, digital audit, media performance buying, social, web & mobile analytics, SEO diagnostics, and Experience Intelligence.

With 23 years' experience as digital practitioner, Chewy started his digital journey right after earning a Business Economics degree from the University of the Philippines in 1999; he worked for Asia Online – then the digital agency handling all of Nestle Philippines' digital requirements.

Chewy then moved to DDB Philippines in 2004 as Strategic Planner, handling Johnson & Johnson and PLDT Business Solutions - helping the latter launch the first ever mobile internet productivity service called WeRoam. In 2007, he moved to the country's largest mobile content provider Xurpas as the head of mobile marketing, expanding the Smart business ten-fold and acquiring additional blue-chip clients in under a year.

Prior to his current role, he served as managing partner at Tribal Worldwide Philippines (formerly Tribal DDB) from 2008 to 2017, leading new business acquisitions, developing new digital services, e-commerce and digital media, while handling bluechip client partners.

Eric Peña has served as Managing Partner of Agile Intelligence since 2017, where he makes use of his expertise in data and analytics, business intelligence, martech, adtech, social media marketing, web analytics, and computer and network operations.

Prior to this, he had served as the Head of Social Intelligence at digitally centric agency Tribal Worldwide Philippines (formerly Tribal DDB) for six years.

One of his distinct past experiences was serving as Head of the Social Networks, New Media Bureau of the 2009-2010 Presidential Campaign of then Senator Noynoy Aquino.

He worked in IT-oriented companies following his six-year stint as Director for Systems Development at the Armed Forces of the Philippines' Computer Systems Center.

A member of Philippine Military Academy (PMA) Class of 1986, he served in the Philippine Constabulary Special Action Force for 5 years, and was the commanding officer of the 4th Special Action Company before he transferred to the Philippine Airforce. From serving in the military, he gained expertise in airborne ops, ranger ops, counter revolutionary warfare, military intelligence, and VIP security.

In today's meeting, we are fortunate to have the executives of a leading data analytics firm in the country visit us. We have Agile Intelligence's Managing Director Chewy Chua and Managing Partner Eric Peña as our guest speakers. Of course, Chewy is my eldest son, and Agile Intelligence is the data analytics unit of DDB Group Philippines.

They will enlighten us about the rapid developments in articial intelligence or AI and how it is taking over the world.

I thought about inviting them here at our club for a talk after listening to their presentation in our Execom at DDB last February. They talked about the latest in artificial inteligence such as the mind-boggling AI chatbots like ChatGPT. Launched in November 2022, ChatGPT quickly attracted the world's attention for its detailed and articulate answers across a wide range of topics. It is the current record holder for the fastest application to have 100 million users... in two months.

I want to share with all of you what I learned by inviting Chewy and Eric to talk about this in detail in our meeting today. Let's give them our full attention later.

Next week, we will have our future district governor Jay Tambunting as our speaker. Thanks DGE Jay for agreeing to be our guest speaker next week. In two-and-a-half months, DGE Jay will assume his post as our new governor, and I can't wait to hear some leadership advice from him as well as some initial plans he may



already have for District 3830.

After DGE Jay, we have lined up speakers including Junior other (JA) **Philippines** Achievement Executive Director Krishna Alejandrino, St. Luke's Medical Center Chief Medical Officer Dr. Benjamin Campomanes, one of the region's most prominent creative advocates Merlee Jayme, and entrepreneur and SME advocate Jorge Wieneke.

So that's our speakers for the rest of April and for next month.

Let me now give you some project updates for the week.

For our Gift of Life program, as I mentioned just before our Holy Week break, we already surpassed our target of 200 heart operations for this current rotary year. And we still have over two months remaining before my term ends. As of today, we have already done 211 surgeries. We have also so far provided for this rotary year 1,736 guaranteed medical assistance from Cong. Paul Daza.

We have our international grants to thank for this, and most especially you, Men of Zest, for your generous donations of time and money. Congrats to our Project Chair Gerry Limcaoco and all the officers and members who have supported this project. Too many to mention now. We will have a separate "roll call" for this some other time to show my appreciation for your support.

For our Gift of Sight - Cataract Surgery Project, eight patients will undergo eye cataract surgery on Saturday, April 15, at the Medsurg Eye Center in BF Homes, Parañaque. The lead doctor is our very own Dr. Timmy Tan with the help of Dr. Ed Gomez and Dr. Manjo Singson. We will provide lunch for the patients and their companions, as well as for the medical team. Patients will also be provided with transportation allowance. Four follow up checkups are to be completed after the operation.

For our Gift of Mobility - Artificial Limbs Project, casting of limbs is scheduled on April 26 at Pasig SPED, Caruncho Avenue, Pasig City.

For our Mass Wedding project, 26 couples are confirmed to join our club sponsored wedding on April 29



at the San Fernando De Dilao Parish in Paco, Manila. RCMW will provide the couples' wedding attire complete with accessories, namely, veil, cord, and aras. We will also provide a wedding reception for the couples and their guests. For those who want to donate gifts in kind or in cash to these couples, please coordinate these with the secretariat.

Ihope you can also support the Rotaract Club of Makati West's fundraising for their "Feed the Young Minds" (FTYM) project for the next Rotary Year. Hosted by our Rotaractors, the FYTM project is an annual community outreach that helps younger children be exposed to basic education through fun learning activities. QUITTERS & STAYERS

I recently read an alarming article in the New York Times, indicating that 4.5 million American's voluntarily left their jobs in a particular month, as workers take advantage of strong employer demand to pursue better opportunities. There is a confluence of events that is causing both the increase in job creation and people quitting. Once the US economy started reopening, confidence returned. People felt more comfortable leaving the safe confines of their homes and venturing out into the world. Therefore, the quit rate serves as a measure of a worker's ability to leave a job, confident that they could secure a new one. The US experience is not far from ours, as we learn to live with the virus.

I've often talked of 'stay interviews' which I think we should be devoting more time and effort to. As Stephen Stills (a storied US musician) once wisely said - 'love the one you're with'.

Of course we learn a lot from exit interviews too. Though I argue its more valuable to prioritize 'stay interviews'.

Staff retention, rewards, recognition and renewal are valuable operational topics worthy of our consideration at this time. In today's knowledge economy, it's important to regularly understand why our staff stay, why people leave and how the organisation may need to change.

Let's keep talking to all our staff, new and seasoned, their views are always valuable.



As inspiration, here's some thoughts on 'stay interview' questions.

- What do you look forward to when you come in or log onto work each day?
- What do you like most or least about working at the company?
- What keeps you working at the company?
- What is the degree to which your role is aligned to the company's vision, values and mission?
- If you could change something about your job or the company overall, what would it be?
- What would make your job more engaging here?
- How do you like to be rewarded or recognized? What intervals?
- Do you feel under-utilized or under resourced to deliver excellence?
- What talents are we not aware of or using in your current role?
- What would you like to learn here?
- What motivates (or demotivates) you?
- What should the company start, stop or continue?
- What do you tell your friends and family about working here?
- Are we reactive, proactive or anticipatory towards our clients or customers?
- What are the barriers or hurdles we need to clear for you to excel?
- What can the leadership do to help you grow your career here?
- What can I (your manager) do to best support you?
- What might tempt you to leave?


