PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE





SCOTCH CORNER

The word for this week is:

"Links" n. pl [lɪŋks]

The sandy undulating ground, generally covered with turf, bent grass, gorse, etc., which is frequently found near the seashore on a flat part of the coast, and is often common ground belonging to the nearest town. Often these were (and are) used for playing golf, and so many of the most famous golf courses in the UK are known as "Links" because the share this common terrain. In the north west of the country, similar land is known as "Machair", but it is often more calcerious and has lower mineral content.

"Links" are also sausages, of the type most people are familiar with: those that come in a skin and are formed in a kind of string. Traditional Scottish sausage (Lorne sausage) is cut from a block and is square. It is REALLY yummy!

Cragganmore

Diageo has featured Cragganmore as its Speyside in its Classic Malts collection since 1987. The distillery was founded in 1869 on the Ballindalloch Castles estate by "Big John" Smith, who previously managed the distilleries at Macallan and Glenlivet and was the lessee of Glenfarclas. So at the age of 36 he was steeped in whisky! He was well-named, weighing upwards of 140kg. A railway-enthusiast, he ensured that Cragganmore was the first distillery to be connected to the railways, though he himself was too large to fit in the carriages and had to travel in the guards van.

The distillery was family-owned until 1923 until sold to White Horse Distillers, which later formed part of Diageo.

The whisky itself is known for being quite light and floral - an easy dram that begs you to have a second glass or more, but not one that the Laphroig-lovers will necessarily appreciate.

Tasting Note by The Chaps at Master of Malt (12y)

Nose: Aromatic, floral. Heather, fruit salad, creamy texture. Smoked almonds, stemmy hav.

Palate: Rich, honey, stone fruits, chestnuts, walnuts, almonds. Berries.

Finish: Smoky, good length, delicate peppery spice
