
PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



It is also the reason that we are trying to learn your views on the matter of potentially opening our membership to ladies. Each point is made with sincerity, with caring and because it may not initially jibe with that of the reader, it doesn't make it wrong or thoughtless.

One thing we've had to learn to accept this past year is that everyone has a different reaction to the Covid Pandemic. SCOTCH CORNER

The word for this week is:

Fouter, n.v. Also footer, -re, foutre, fut(t)er, f(o)utor, foutar, fuiter; foo(t)ther ['fu:tər]

As a verb (which is far more common), this means to fiddle about, to bungle, act carelessly or generally potter about aimlessly. Often when we were dawdling about as kids, with adults intent on going somewhere, we'd hear the amonission "dinna fouter aboot, get a move on!".

As a noun, it refers to a person who is feckless, a layabout or a shirker, someone who lacks direction and purpose. Interestingly it use to be applied half-jocularly to an old man or to a childless husband.

I used to think it had been derived from the French word "foutre" (I'll let you Google that one). Which by no means belies anything about my technique with the ladies...

Scottish Heritage Tomatin Sited 25 miles south of Inverness, there is evidence of folks buying whisky for a local still in the 16th century, and the Tomatin distillery was the largest in Scotland during the 1970s, peaking at around 12.5m litres a year. Its probably fair to say "its nae a bonnie wan". In truth, this is a Highland whisky with a mixed history of product quality and almost all production used to go into blends such as Johnnie Walker, J&B and Chivas Regal. But since Japanese owners took over in 1987, there has been more focus on quality over quantity and the statement 12 year old single malt is a fair quaff. With only 4 of its 6 spirit stills currently in use, there is plenty of room for expansion, so drink up! In 2014, the Tomatin 12 Year Old was given an update and bottled at 43% ABV rather 40%, as it was previously. It is finished for six-to-nine months in Oloroso Sherry casks before being bottled. Tasting Note by The Chaps at Master of Malt (12y) **Nose:** Buttery at first, but notes of raisin and almond soon take over. Palate: Oak-y vanilla and fresh mint, dotted with stem ginger and driedorange peel. **Finish:** Currant buns, a hint of raspberry jam, barley.

Mr. Shambhu S. Kumaran joined the Indian Foreign Service in 1995.

His diplomatic assignments abroad include postings in Frankfurt and Berlin (1997-2002), as Political Counsellor in Kathmandu (2007-2009) and as Deputy High Commissioner to South Africa (2009-2012).

At Headquarters, he was Deputy Secretary (West Europe Division) handling relations with the United Kingdom, Germany, Spain as well as the Commonwealth from 2002-2004. He was Officer on Special Duty (Press Relations) in the External Publicity Division from 2004-2007.

During January 2016- May 2019, he was on deputation to the Ministry of Defence as Joint Secretary (Planning and International Cooperation).

He was Ambassador of India to the Kingdom of Morocco from June 2019 to July 2020.

He holds a Bachelors Degree in English Literature from Kerala University as well as an MA in International Studies and Master of Philosophy in Diplomatic Studies from Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi.







