

Is the Group Chief Culture Officer of DDB Group Philippines (DDB), one of the country's leading integrated marketing communications groups. As Culture Chief, Anna takes care of DDB's people through The Culture Hub, which functions as the agency group's human resources, talent management and corporate communications department.

Enabling DDB Group's people focused management, The Culture Hub under Anna's leadership has nurtured and motivated the group's talents to achieve their utmost potential through purposeful training, a culture of holistic health, and a diverse and inclusive workplace.

In 2020, Anna became the first Filipina to win the "Diversity Champion" title at Campaign Asia-Pacific's Women Leading Change Awards. The following year, DDB Group Philippines won a Gold Stevie for "Most Exemplary Employer" and another Gold Stevie for "Company of the Year", plus a People's Choice Stevie Award for Favorite Companies.

### Why Our Club Organizes Mass Wedding

A hearty "thank you" also goes to the 34 Men of Zest for their donations that allowed us to turn their wedding day into a festive demonstration of happiness and joy.

Marriage is a big step for anyone. More so for these couples as cohabiting has become more commonplace in our society.

The lines between getting married and just "living in" or moving in together have blurred, making it difficult, especially for young people, to recognize what is so special about the marriage vows.

Our club undertakes this project because most of us have been raised with an awareness of the sanctity of marriage.

We facilitate the sacred ceremony to provide them with an opportunity to consecrate their commitment to one another in the presence of God, friends and family.

reationship as they assume their responsibilities and declare their promises of love and fidelity to one another. It is our belief that such a public declaration makes the parties accountable.

In a marriage seminar I once attended, I remember Pastor Gus Lising explaining that marriage is more than just a civil contract. He said: "...marriage is central to God's plan for our happiness and His desire is for us to receive love, support, and care; and this happens best through an honest and devoted marriage..."

A wedding celebration is in fact a declaration by the couple of their lifetime commitment to each other. In the end, it strengthens their resolve to keep the commitment to the marriage. Of course there are no guarantees.

The primary reason these couples have remained unmarried is that all the grooms are blue collar workers with no savings. A simple church wedding can easily cost about P100,000. They cannot afford it.

Msgr. Rolando Dela Cruz, Parish Priest of San Fernando Parish who officiated the recent ceremonies, spoke to the couples about building strong relationships with each other. It reminded me of the saying,


