

As the Paris 2024 Olympics finishes, Filipino's have shown both our resiliency, determination, and unfortunately, our capacity to be slightly disorganized. Team Philippines had their best showing to date: 2 golds and 2 bronze medals. Congratulations to our athletes and their teams!

In the news was the logistical hiccup for the golf team's uniforms, which sparked public outcry and highlighted the need for better support and organization for our athletes. While the uniform issue was a setback, it serves as a reminder of the importance of comprehensive planning and support for our sports teams. Ensuring that our athletes have everything they need to compete at their best should be a top priority. Moving forward, addressing these organizational gaps will help us build on the successes of the Paris 2024 Olympics and continue to inspire future generations of Filipino athletes.

Speaking of organizational prowess which I rarely possess, I'd like to give a special shout out to PE/Chairman Dino, PP Eric Angeles and PP Eric Tensuan for spearheading our 55th anniversary and the 20th anniversary of the Gift of Life in the Philippines. The theme "Bigger, Better, Stronger" will emphasize the programs (with GOL in the spotlight of course), their history and how we can continue these programs so they will live on well past our lifetimes.

Ms. Yong Davalos will be preparing a sort-of fashion show. We need 20 Rotarians and 20 Rotary Anns for this project. Time commitment wise, we are looking at 2 practices and 2 fittings for the outfits. It isn't a huge time commitment, and we'll need everyone's help to showcase to our district, sister clubs, doctor's and guests what has been, and what can be accomplished.

PP Roque and Dir. EDSA will be leading the souvenir program which I will most likely bug you for a contribution in the near future.

Service Updates

For our Gift of Life (GOL) program, we have done 54 surgeries from July 1 to the present, including the (11) operations done yesterday at the De Los Santos Medical Center (DLSMC). We have also given 265 medical assistances from Cong. Paul Daza.

For our Gift of Sight (GOS) Cataract operation, 43 patients are scheduled for eye cataract surgery this Saturday, August 17 at Medsurg Eye Center, BF Homes, Parañaque City.

For our Gift of Mobility (GOM) Artificial Limbs, 11 amputee patients have been screened with Dra. Penny Bundoc on July 18, 2024, at the UERM Hospital.

For Breast and Cervical Cancer Screening (BCCS), 131 women were screened in Gen. Trias, Cavite on August 7. 15 were found to have breast mass, and 3 had Cervix findings.

The Philippine Cancer Society performed a cryotherapy (treats a variety of tissue lesions) for those who have cervical problems. The ultrasound was also done on-site for patients who have breast mass. There are four (4) more BCCS locations to be conducted this Rotary Year: Alabang Country Club on Sept 2; Pila, Laguna on Sept 14; Victoria, Laguna on Sept 15; and Calauan, Laguna on Sept 15.
