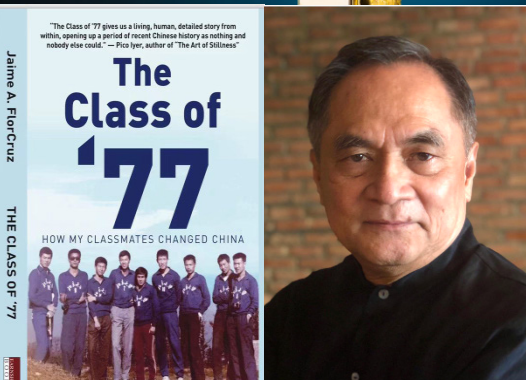

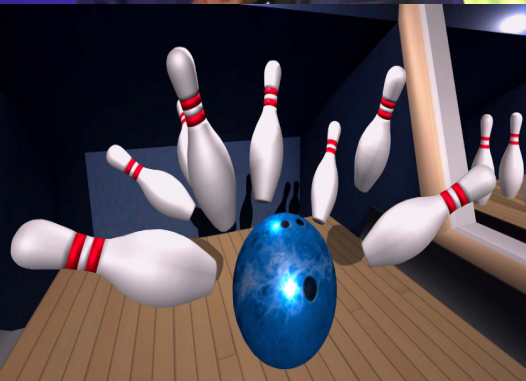

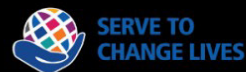

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Club Recognition Awards

**“When people are financially invested, they want a return.
When people are emotionally invested, they want to contribute.”
– Simon Sinek**

This year our annual club recognition awards is on June 15th. These awards give recognition of what a member has done and show genuine appreciation of his value as a member.

Appreciation has to do with feelings. In the words of Maya Angelou... “I’ve learned that people will forget what you said, people will forget what you did, but people will never forget how you made them feel.”

As we are a voluntary club, our members do not receive monetary returns. Instead, we can give them something more valuable, psychological or emotional income.

Recognizing club members leads to greater engagement, which strengthens member retention and increases club accomplishments while it creates a more positive club culture.

I must confess that I have one regret. If I had to do it again, I would have also done a Club Mid-Year Recognition Awards.

For those that may be tentative about giving positive feedback in your personal and professional lives, here are 5 points to consider.

1. Be sincere. Insincere praise is nothing



but flattery and is worse than no praise at all. It also causes a loss of credibility.

2. Praise based on specifics: This gives the praise more substance, reinforcing the outcome you want to nurture.

3. Explain their impact. Explain the importance of how their work is contributing to the organization's success. Ask if there is anything you can do to support their continued effort.

4. Communicate praise promptly. This will boost their morale and motivate them to continue to do good work.

5. Praise in public. Praise given in the presence of their peers gives it more impact and encourages everyone to do better.

In closing, let me also share a few influence skills.

Make it a habit to consistently thank and express honest appreciation.

Make it your business to lift one person up every day.

Anytime anyone has a positive thing to say about a colleague, spread it around quickly, more widely, beyond their immediate circle.

In the words of the American writer, Jim Stovall...“You need to be aware of what others are doing, applaud their efforts, acknowledge their successes, and encourage them in their pursuits. When we all help one another, everybody wins”.

Finally, as always, let's continue to execute on our theme, “Increase Our Capacity to Serve” and remember our winning 3R's: Recognize, Retain and Recruit. Onwards and upwards!

5. Praise in public. Given in the presence of the peers gives it more impact and encourages others to do better.

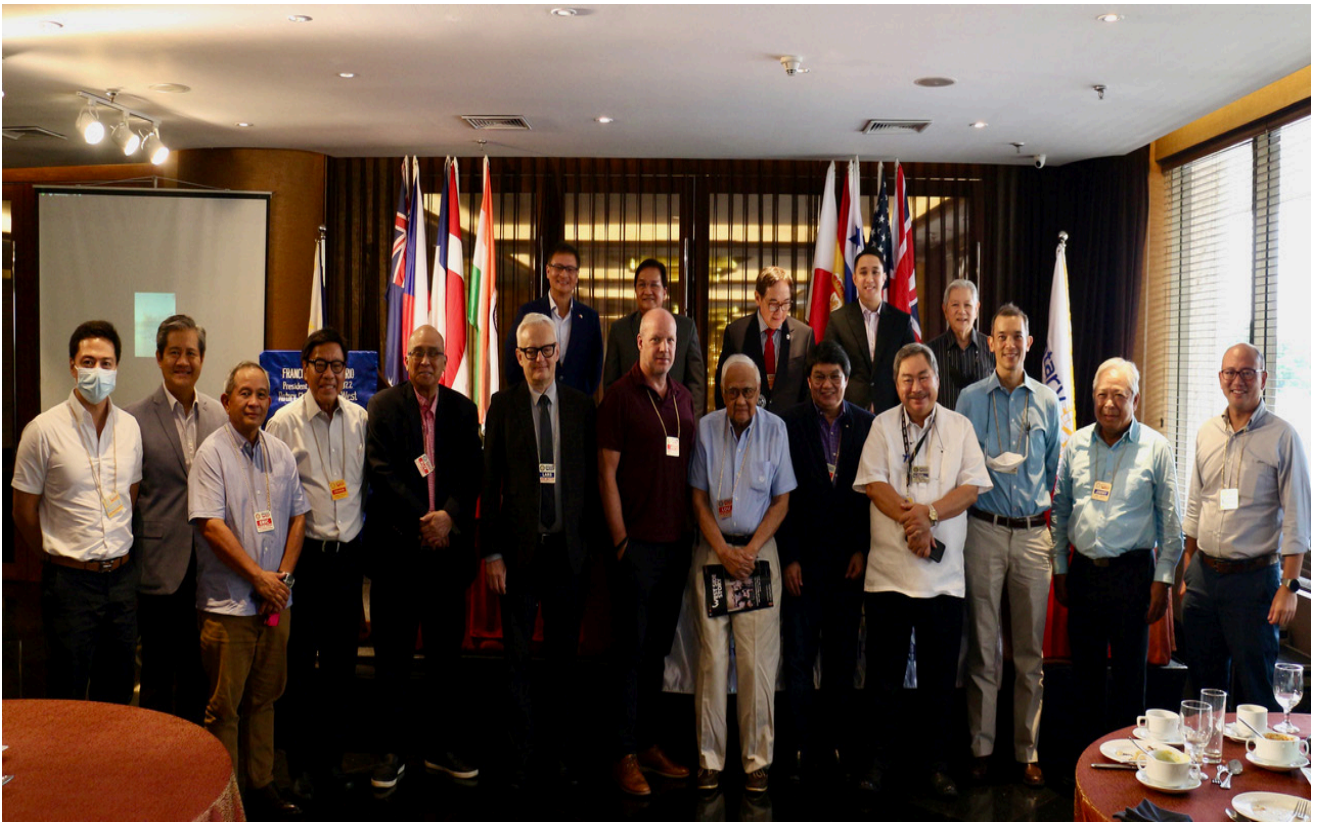
