Scottish Heritage

Arran Robert Burns (10 yrs) (pronounced 'Ar-RAN')

From one of Scotland's newest distilleries, on the island where President Al's parents live. There used to be over 50 illicit stills on the island in the late 18th century, but the taxman shut them down. So when the Arran Distillery opened in 1995, it filled a gap of over a hundred years.

The Robert Burns is made in homage to the Scottish National Bard, himself an excise man at one point. It is, in your President's own words, "very good value". Matured in bourbon barrels, which gives it a hint of sweetness.

Tasting Note by The Chaps at Master of Malt Nose: Apple peels, a little pear juice, hints of coconut and apple blossom. Develops with custard and cinnamon. Palate: Fruity and rich, vanilla, pannacotta, apple and lime peel. Finish: Apple strudel and cinnamon on the finish.







