Golf

The first documented mention of golf in Scotland appears in a 1457 Act of the Scottish Parliament, an edict issued by King James II prohibiting the playing of the games of gowf and futball as these were a distraction from archery practice for military purposes.

Unlike in most countries, golf is an egalitarian sport in Scotland, with a plethora of affordable, public courses. There are over 587 courses in Scotland - that's one for every 10,000 inhabitants. Some of the most fun are those built over farmland, where the basic origins of the game become so apparent in contrast to the manicured and perfected turfs of many modern golf courses.


Among the most famous courses are The Old Course (dating form the 1400s), Carnoustie (1840s), Prestwick (host of the first Open Championship in 1851), Royal Troon (1878) nearby Turnberry (1901, sadly now owned by Donald Trump) and Muirfield (1744).

RTN. ROBIN GARCIA CEO, WR Numero Research

Prof. Robin Michael U. Garcia, Ph.D. is a Shanghai-educated political scientist, professor and entrepreneur. He is the CEO of WR Numero Research, a technology-driven public opinion research firm. He also founded Warwick & Roger (W&R) an advisory firm with expertise in political economic risk, public policy and strategy.

Currently, he is an Assistant Professor at the Political Economy Program of the School of Law and Governance of the University of Asia & the Pacific (UA&P). He has also lectured at De La Salle University in Manila and the University of the Philippines in Diliman. Recently, he was appointed as a Non-Resident Fellow at the Albert Del Rosario Institute for International and Strategic Studies (ADRi)

Robin specializes in political psychology, political economy and international relations in the context Southeast Asia, the Philippines and China. For his expertise, he been invited to deliver keynote addresses at the British Chamber of Commerce Myanmar, Mongolian Ministry of Food and Agriculture, Consular Corps of the Philippines, the Doing Business in Asia Alliance Annual Meetings, University of the Philippines Diliman, Ateneo de Manila University, the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) Peace Summit. His commentary has appeared in The National Interest, Eurasia Review, Rappler, CNN, South China Morning Post, Inuds News, Bloomberg Mongolia, Analyzing War among others. Moreover, he has advised top government leaders and multinational companies on political economic developments in the Philippines and in Asia.

At just 27 years of age, he obtained a Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) in Politics and International Relations degree from the School of International Relations and Public Affairs (SIRPA) of Fudan University in Shanghai, China where he was distinguished with the Dean's Award for Academic Excellence in 2017. He also holds a Master of Public Administration major in Public Policy from the University of the Philippines' National College of Public Administration and Governance (UP-NCPAG) in 2013, as well as a Bachelor of Arts in Development Studies from De La Salle University 2010 where he was awarded the Gawad Magaaral (Distinguished Student) Award.






