We have already lined up our club meetings and fellowships in September. For our next meeting, September 7, we will have Philip Kwa to talk on Cybersecurity and how to secure your business against cyber threats.

On Sept. 14, we will have a luncheon in Delos Santos Medical Center with Dra. Louisa Go as speaker. We will be joined by GOL beneficiaries and other doctors in this activity.

We will also be having a bowling fellowship on either Sept. 19, 20 or 21.

And on September 26, there will be another joint meeting this time with RC Makati.

Project Updates

Let me now give you some project updates.

For our flagship program Gift of Life, we have 39 surgeries completed these first two months of the rotary year. We have also so far extended from July 1 to date medical assistance from Cong. Paul Daza fund to 650 beneficiaries.

One GOL beneficiary had an open-heart surgery today, August 31, at the National Children’s Hospital while two more are



scheduled separately on September 4 and 7. There are also scheduled heart (PDA and PPBV) procedures at DLSMC which will be on September 13 for a tentative number of 15 patients.

We will also be busy this Sunday, September 3, as the club will lead the repainting of 50 decade-old houses including the village's Multipurpose Hall at the Gawad Kalinga (GK)-RCMW Village in Pinagsama, Taguig City. My family and I will be there, as well as our satellite club members led by Kai and Jameson, and the rest of the RCMW secretariat will be there too. And of course, the bulk of the volunteers will come from this GK village itself.

As mentioned before, we will also be donating three fire extinguishers to this community to complement core groups' training on fire protection.

Next Saturday, September 9, we will have the turnover of wheelchairs. We have so far 34 beneficiaries in our list, but only 30 are allotted for the club. I hope everyone gets to receive a wheelchair.

Then on September 25, the club will be holding Breast and Cervical Cancer Screening at the Alabang Golf and Country Club.

So that's for our project updates. Please get in touch with me and our other officers, and/or the secretariat should you wish to be part of any of these projects and activities.



