Olympic Gold Medalist Hidylin Diaz, An Inspiration For The Philippines

Newton Smith hosted a fireside chat on "Succeeding in Uncertain Times". Newton took on this topic not from a business standpoint but from an individual perspective. He claims that we can gain control up to 80% of what happens if we have a plan. He shared with us his plan that he put in a matrix- that listed several focus areas and the corresponding set of key actions with specific objectives for each focus area. Newton's fireside chat led me to do some reflection.

For some reason, I felt like Newton was speaking directly at me - as I am guilty of so much that we should avoid doing! As for everything else that we can't control Newton offers a piece of advice that is good for the soul: there is no point stressing over something things we cannot control. In fact, this Tuesday, I lost internet connection at home. I wasted most of the morning trying to restore the connection. I finally gave up and I went to my office at The Bridge School in Paranaque. I kept reminding myself, "it-is-what-it-is" this is beyond my control.

One thing that is not good for the soul is engaging in negative talk to ourselves. To me, the single most important skill in life is how I communicate to others. But the next most important skill is how I communicate to myself. For most of my waking moments, I am unconsciously talking to myself. The problem is I am engaged in not just positive but also negative self-talk.

For example, when I make a mistake, I have told myself, "Franco, you're such an idiot!", At the time I am saying this to myself, I am not conscious that this is a self-defeating behavior. If I say this enough times over many years, slowly I might become less and less confident. If this becomes a habit, I will not be able to accomplish my goals and end up frustrated.

On the other hand, if I speak positively to myself and I have had some success in my undertaking, I get more excited to work even harder. I become my own cheerleader and I would say to myself, "Great job, Franco!". I am a believer of celebrating success, however small; as success begets success. Pre-pandemic, I would take out Tere, my wife for a fancy dinner to celebrate this success. My point is I trace it back simply to the way I communicated to myself as where it all started for me to gain success. I can do all the planning and developing strategies but it is likely to fail in the execution if I engage in negative self-talk.

Hidylin Diaz won the Olympic gold medal because she had a dream and worked towards it, while constantly raising the standards for herself. She believed in herself - no matter what adversities she faced in life. She came from a poor family and lived with her parents and five siblings in Zamboanga City.

Even when Hidylin's name appeared as part of a "plot to discredit" the government, it did not deter her from her Olympic ambitions. She dismissed the government's claims in her 2019 Facebook post, "I am focused on my Tokyo 2020 goal." I would consider that as positive self-talk.

We can look forward to yet another brilliant speaker next Thursday: Craig Lonnee, Chief Development Officer of the DDB Group. Craig facilitated our club's planning review over a few Saturdays in June. Craig will also be relating his presentation on the application to our club. A sneak preview of some of the material he will be covering would be about culture is our strategy while avoiding groupthink, and about leadership. Craig says leadership is lonely and leaders need to accept moments of isolation. Don't miss it!
