

He founded and started the Infosecurity Chapter of Singapore Computer Society. He is a fellow member of the Singapore Computer Chapter. He holds the position of Deputy General Treasurer at Tech Talent Assembly, a non-profit organisation under NTUC that focuses on enabling PMETs to be future work ready. He serves as the Audit Chair at ACE (Action Community For Entrepreneurship) Singapore and was the Audit Chair at a Singapore Manufacturing Company listed on the HKEX

Cybersecurity

For business executives, government officials, and professionals here at the Rotary Club of Makati West, cybersecurity is something that we want to know more of.

This is because lack of it will make us vulnerable to cybercrimes, and we naturally want to protect our businesses, organizations and even personal finances against it. In addition, we want to be knowledgeable enough about this topic so we can also guide our colleagues and other industry players on how to avoid and prevent it from happening in their midst.

That being said, I am happy to have as our guest speaker for today's club meeting one of the country's well-known cybersecurity enthusiasts, Mr. Philip Kwa. He is currently the program director of the Master of Cybersecurity program at the Asian Institute of Management. I hope everyone will listen intently as he will be talking about how to secure your business against cyber threats.





Expect more tech savvy speakers like Philip during my term because that's the industry I am most familiar with.

On Sept. 14, we will have a special lunch meeting at the Delos Santos Medical Center with Dra. Louisa Joanna Go as speaker. We will be joined by GOL beneficiaries and other doctors in this activity.

We will also be having a Fellowship on Sept. 21 at Studio 300 - Pasig City, the first and only all-around recreational bowling center in the country.

And on September 26, there will be another joint meeting this time with RC Makati and our speaker will be Mr. Luis Felipe Lopez, Head of Technology, Base Bahay Foundation. That will be at the Manila Peninsula.

Project Updates

Let me now give you some project updates.

For our Gift of Life program, we have 43 surgeries completed so far this rotary year. We have also extended medical



assistance from Cong. Paul Daza fund to 642 beneficiaries.

We had a scheduled open heart surgery on our GOL beneficiary today, September 7, done at the National Children's Hospital. There will also be PDA Device Closure and 2 PPBV procedures at DLSMC on September 13 for a tentative number of 12 patients.

ON September 9, we will have the turnover of units for our Wheelchair for Life Project with 31 beneficiaries to receive their wheelchairs this Saturday, from 9:00 am onwards at the Phil. Red Cross, Logistics and Multi-Purpose Center in Mandaluyong City. This is in partnership with the Rotary Club of Manila 101, the host club.

Last Sunday, September 3, we were supposed to do the repainting of the Gawad Kalinga (GK)-RCMW Village in Pinagsama, Taguig City but this was postponed due to inclement weather. We will instead have the activity this Sunday, Sep. 10.

Our club will lead the repainting of 50 decade-old houses including the village's Multipurpose Hall. My family and I will be



there, as well as our satellite club members and the RCMW secretariat. And of course, the bulk of the volunteers will come from this GK village itself. Please join us if you can.

Then on September 25, we will be holding Breast and Cervical Cancer Screening at the Alabang Golf and Country Club.

Last but the least, the Rotary Anns project - the Basic Baking Demo Class - already started yesterday at the Maya Kitchen in Liberty Center, Arnaiz Ave., Legazpi Village, Makati. 


