


SCOTCH CORNER

PP EDUARDO "EDDIE" YAPPresident RY 2015-2016, RC Makati

A degree in business administration and a Certified Public Accountant (CPA) by training, businessman-property developer by vocation, concert producer by avocation, and keen observer and advocate of public policy in fiscal matters, monetary policy, financial markets and public transportation, among others.
