FAQs? PREVIEW

Q: What is the RCMW Guardian Angel Program (GAP)?
A: GAP is a follow up program to the RCMW Gift of Life (GOL) Project to continue to monitor our GOL beneficiaries and their families after surgery.

Q: What are my responsibilities as a Guardian Angel?
A: With the GAP committee providing you with information and support, to monitor the general medical status of your ward and his parents in order to ensure that the child complies with the required post operation check up's and 20 Echo 6 months and one year after their surgery.

Q: Am I obligated to help my ward financially?
A: There is no obligation to provide any financial assistance to your ward.

- We held the turnover of a hand-washing station to complement our e-learning community center and in support of our GK Pinagsama village.



- The club renewed our invitation to the membership to be involved in our Guardian Angel Program (GAP), a follow-up to our club’s Gift of Life (GOL) Project. The main function of guardian angels is simply to monitor our GOL beneficiaries and their families after surgery. Only 20% of our members have accepted the role of guardian angel. Therefore I appeal to you to sign up, in order that no GoL beneficiary remains without a dedicated guardian angel.

- Our club was first to qualify for the district grant collaboration with Knowledge Channel Foundation’s, “Teaching in the New Normal for Early Childhood Development”.
- On October 19th, our club participated in a district learning session where I shared about our fireside chats and home clusters.

- Forty members submitted their responses to a survey regarding in-person meetings. Eighty eight percent of the respondents indicated they would attend in-person meetings while 82% considered attendance of fully vaccinated households as an essential/important consideration.

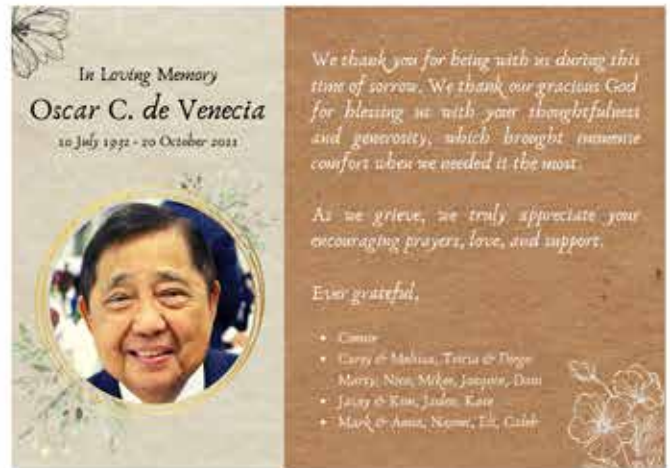

- The club mourned the passing of our beloved PDG Oskie de Venecia on October 20. PDG Oskie was the 13th RCMW president.

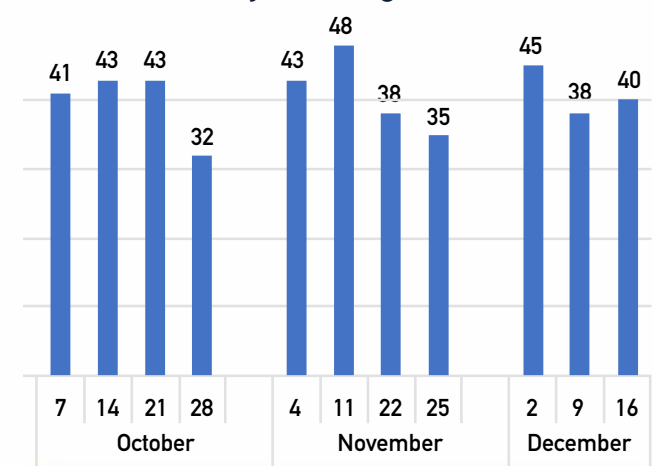

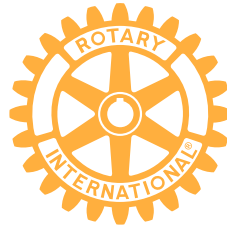


TOKENIZATION AND BLOCKCHAIN-READY WITH OUR VERY OWN RCMW NFT

Get to know RCMW President Franco del Rosario

RCMW President Franco del Rosario comes from a family of Rotarians. His father, Ambassador Toting, was RC Manila's past president, while his brother Carlos was RC Makati's past president.

After an overseas stint of 22 years, Franco returned to the Philippines in 1996 and was sponsored to the Club by the late PDG Tony Rufino; he was named "Baby Rotarian of the Year" in his first year. In the next years, he would serve as director for most avenues of service including club service, international service, and community service and in RY 2001 – 2002 was named "Rotarian of the Year" by then Pres. TG Limcaoco.

In RY 2020 2021, as President-Elect and Chair of the Membership Committee, Franco started "fireside chats" during the pandemic and sought topics and speakers, and brought in seven guest speakers for the weekly lunch meetings. For all his work, he was awarded the "No One Cares More" award by IPP AL.

A U.S. Certified Dale Carnegie Instructor, Franco is an Executive coach at Six Sigma Consulting, where he mentors CEOs of local companies and C-suite senior executives of multinational companies, and also serves as executive and planning review facilitator. He is currently The Bridge School, Inc.'s Head of Development and CFO and a club shares specialist.

Previously, he worked in IBM in the US for 15 years in various management roles in Finance and Marketing. Prior to this, he worked In Dole for 10 years in the Philippines, Nicaragua and Korea, and served as Head of Supply Chain for Japan and the Middle East. At Langdon & Seah Philippines, Inc. (Arcadis), he was Head of the Strategy and Corporate Development, as well as the Environmental Sustainability business.

He served as Vice President and Governor at the Management Association of the Philippines (MAP) where he chaired the MAP Annual CEO conference for five years, making a net profit of over P10M. He was a Green Associate for Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) of the US Green Building Council.

He graduated from De La Salle University with a dual Lia-Com degree in Accounting and Political Science, and earned his MBA with a dual concentration in Finance and Marketing from the Columbia University in New York.

Franco is married to Tere Tabuena. They have one daughter who lives in Manila and two sons living in Seattle. Martin married to Lalita Lai and Marco married to Cesca Gabales. They have one grandson, Remy.
