

Louisa Go, Dr. Dexter Cheng, and our incredible partners – Jaden and Friends, Happy Hearts Foundation, and Heart Warriors Inc. – alongside Chairman Lemarc, is nothing short of heroic. Witnessing this epitome of selfless service, rendered without expectation of personal gain or fame, has been one of the greatest honors of my life. My sincere thanks to each of you for your tireless efforts.

The very next day, July 18, Dra. Josephine Bondoc and Director Robbie Leviste spearheaded an artificial limbs turnover for our Gift of Mobility program. Director Robbie, your sustained commitment to this initiative for many years, in partnership with UERM, is truly commendable. Thank you, Dra. Bondoc and Director Robbie, for championing this empowering program with such unwavering dedication.

In August 2024, a vision to celebrate the 55th Anniversary of our Club and the 20th Anniversary of Gift of Life in November 2024 blossomed. 
